SEAFOOD, SIPS & BREW

ASTORIA TO CANNON BEACH

Unwind with fresh seafood, craft beverages and bakery off Highways 30 and 26

Start your foodie trip at **Blackberry Bog Farm** on Highway 30 just east of Astoria. That will set the stage for all that happens just down the road. Grab an Italian-inspired lunch at **Gaetano's Market and Deli**, or if in the mood for fish and chips and chowder, gorge at **South Bay Wild Fish House**. Thirsty? Whet your whistle with craft beverages at **Pilot House Distilling**, **Fort George Brewery** or **Reveille Ciderworks**. After a hike (or nap!), enjoy dinner at **Bridgewater Bistro**. When heading home, stop at **Astoria Sunday Market**, **Astoria Food Hub** and at **FishStix Seafood Market** in Warrenton for take-home goodies.

In Seaside, start the day with the fuel you'll need – breakfast or lunch at **Osprey Cafe**. After a long walk on the beach, peruse crafts at the seasonal **Seaside Farmers Market**, or get a refreshing cone at **Sea Star Gelato**. Soon it's dinner time and **Maggie's on the Prom** beckons with an inventive menu featuring locally sourced ingredients. Or if you have a vacation rental or a cooler with you, go to **Bell Buoy** for fresh seafood and make dinner.

In Cannon Beach, the **Stephanie Inn** offers oceanfront lodging and dining. Choose between its upscale dining room or the more casual seafood-centric **Wayfarer Restaurant**. Evening is best spent with a pint at **Public Coast Brewing** or **Pelican Brewing**, or sample a flight of Scottish whiskeys and a dessert at **MacGregor's Whiskey Bar and Restaurant** or at **Pilot House Distilling**. Daybreak is sublime at **Sea Level Bakery** with their single-origin coffee and treats. And be sure to schedule a cooking class at **EVOO** with Chef Bob Neroni. Before heading home, pick up freshly caught fish at **Ecola Seafoods** or a picnic of fish and chips, or local produce at **Cannon Beach Farmers Market**.

CHEESE, WINE & OCEAN BREEZES

MANZANITA TO BAY CITY

Explore a world of tempting foodie delights off Highways 26 and 6

In Manzanita, three tasty choices: **Big Wave Café** and **Offshore Grill** (both specializing in local foods), and a chance to swirl a glass at **The Winery at Manzanita**. Then pick up a bag of specialty foods or lunch to go at **Wild Manzanita**. And check out the **Manzanita Farmers Market** on Friday evenings in summer.

Schedule a tour at **North Fork 53** in Nehalem, the coast's only tea farm, before indulging in amazing flavors of ice cream (or chowders) at **Buttercup**. End the evening with a flight of whiskeys at **MacGregor's Whiskey Bar** in Manzanita.

Bring your appetite for adventure on a fishing trip with **Garibaldi Charters** or **CS Fishery** in Garibaldi, or a guided paddle and clam harvest with **Kayak Tillamook**. Head to lunch or dinner at **Garibaldi Portside Bistro** across from the marina, or stock up on fish to take home at **The Spot** or **Fishpeople Seafood**.

Dinner at oceanfront **Sand Dollar Restaurant** in Rockaway Beach is a must for sunset lovers, or feast on fish and chips at the **Fish Peddler** in Bay City, overlooking Tillamook Bay. You can pick up fresh oysters there, too. Then rest your full belly at fun spots like **Twins Ranch Covered Wagon Campground** or **Sheltered Nook Tiny Home Village**.

Landlubbers love outdoor adventures with **Explore Nature**, and day trips or dinner trains with **Oregon Coast Scenic Railroad**.

If you're heading to or from the coast on Highway 6 (also known as Trees to Sea Scenic Byway), stop for a delicious meal and pint of beer at **OutAZABlue** and **Slowdrift Brewery**. They're right next door to each other at Gales Creek. Better yet, have **Farm2Fork** tours do the driving for you.



SUDS, SURF & TURF

TILLAMOOK TO NESKOWIN

Savor the flavors of coastal purveyors off Highways 6, 22, and 18

Get your caffeine fix at **Five Rivers Coffee Roasters**, then cross Highway 101 to the **Tillamook Creamery** to sample cheese and ice cream, and see the cheesemakers at work. Nearby **Blue Heron French Cheese Company** boasts more artisan delights. Beer fans flock to **Pelican Brewing**, **Werner Beef & Brew** and the wild fermentation ales of **de Garde Brewing**. Savor a picnic lunch at **Recess Food Truck**.

Around Tillamook, find fresh ingredients from **Food Roots Marketplace**, **Tillamook Meats**, and **JAndy Oysters**. On Saturdays, stop by the **Tillamook Farmers Market**, or pick up produce at **Brickyard Farms** or hydrangeas at **Oregon Coastal Flowers Farm** before heading west on Highway 131 to Netarts Bay. There, pay a visit to **Jacobsen Salt** or indulge in a locally sourced lunch or dinner at **The Schooner**.

Scoot down the Three Capes Route to Pacific City where fresh-baked treats and breakfast or lunch await you at **Grateful Bread Bakery**, a local landmark. For thrills of a lifetime, join a fishing trip with **Pacific City Dory Charters**, catching a wave from the beach. Rest your bones at **Headlands Coastal Lodge & Spa**, where each guestroom features ocean views and the **Meridian Restaurant** creates local food delicacies. Or enjoy dinner at local favorites **Sportsman's Pub-n-Grub** or **The Riverhouse Nestucca**. Then it's time for toasts at **Twist Wine Company** and the original **Pelican Brewing** pub, a beachfront tradition.

Nearby **Nestucca Bay Creamery** beckons with handmade farmstead cheese and ice cream. Head south along Highway 101, where you can't go wrong with a seafood dinner at **Hawk Creek Café** in Neskowin, and if it's summer, get an ice cream cone at their bright red **Village Scoop** food truck. If you want a private tour of special places, contact **Oregon Coast Tours and Transportation**.

TRAVEL TIPS

The North Coast Food Trail is open to visitors throughout the year and is designed to be explored at your own pace. It extends from Astoria, Seaside and Cannon Beach through all of Tillamook County with more than 100 miles of delicious adventures. There's a reason **Sunset Magazine** gave it an Editor's Choice Travel Award for best food tour in the West.

Before setting out along the North Coast Food Trail, plan ahead by mapping your route to make it easy to navigate remote areas without cell service. High season varies per business but is typically May - October. Farmers markets—six of them, from Astoria to Tillamook—operate from mid-May or mid-June through September.

When visiting a farm, we ask that you respect the property, and be cautious around farm animals and equipment. Children must be supervised at all times. Be prepared to follow all site-specific safety rules, and wear appropriate footwear.

Please check the hours of operation for each business online or by phone and note when advance reservations or appointments are required – farms will require appointments. Wear a mask if asked to do so, and use hand sanitizer before and after visiting a farm.

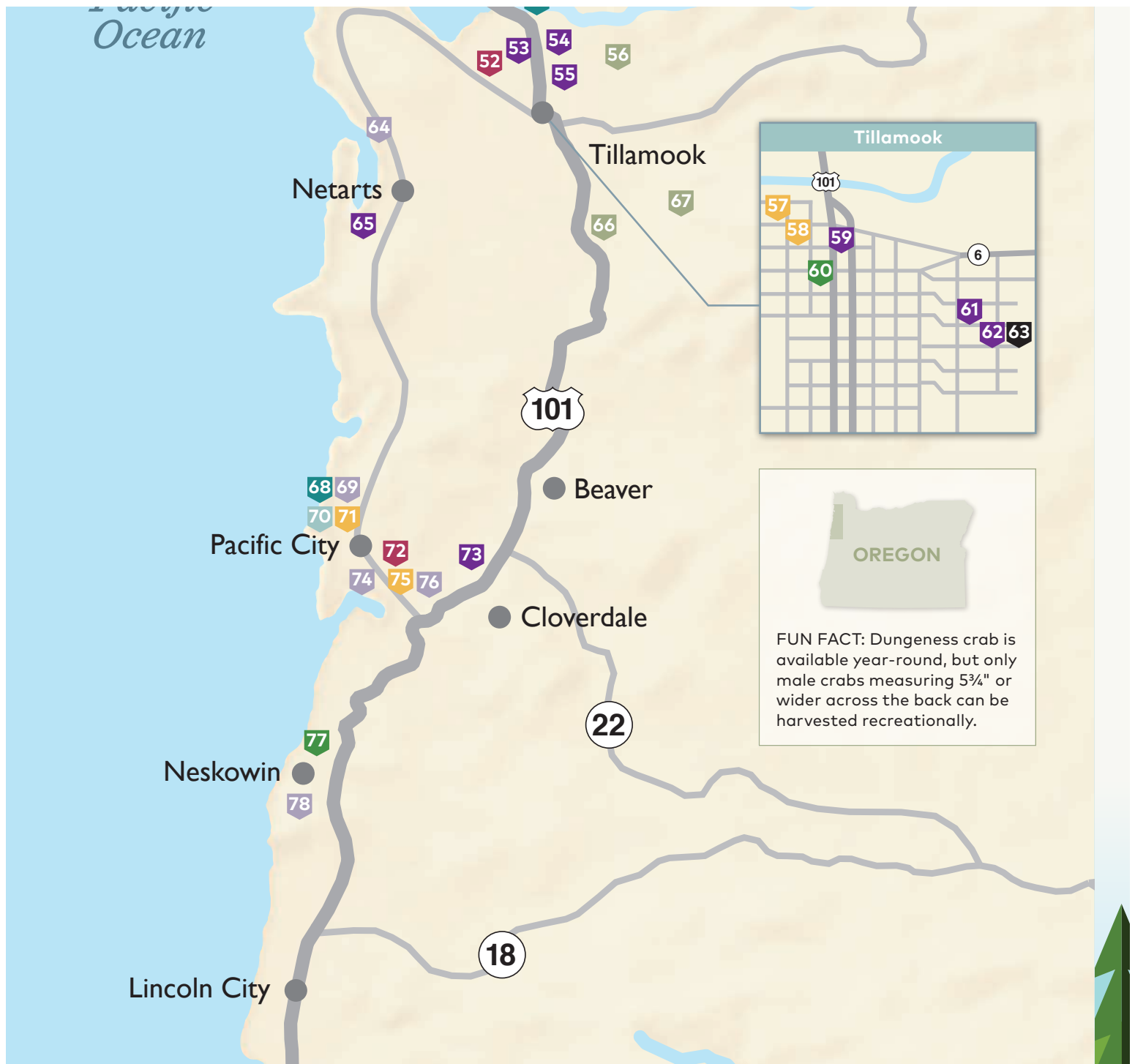
